

KitchenAid Canada Voluntarily recalls toasters

Date: January 1, 2005

Name of Product: KitchenAid® ProLine® Toasters

Units: Estimated 884

Manufacturer: Whirlpool Corp., of Benton Harbor, Mich

Hazard: A potential fire hazard may exist due to a self-starting condition of the toaster. A short interruption of power to the toaster can cause the heating elements to turn on and possibly ignite any flammable items left on top of the toaster. No incidents of property damage or personal injury have been reported in Canada.

Description:

The recalled products are painted die-cast metal / stainless steel 2-slice and 4-slice countertop household toasters, models: (model and serial numbers are on labels affixed to the bottom of the toasters)


Serial Numbers of the recalled products begin with the letters "WTP..." or "WTR..."

Call KitchenAid Canada to arrange for a free replacement. Please have the serial number and model number of the toaster available for the call. Please do not return the toaster to the retailer where it was purchased, as retailers are not prepared to take them back.
