

## Free Standing Range, Double Oven And Oven Microwave Combination 2004 -United States

**Hazard:** Important Safety Notice: Shock Hazard -- Do Not Use Certain Whirlpool and KitchenAid brand free standing range, double oven and oven-microwave combination products

**Description:**

In cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), Whirlpool is voluntarily recalling about 6,000 Whirlpool and KitchenAid brand free standing range, double oven, and oven-microwave combination products.

Certain Whirlpool and KitchenAid brand freestanding ranges, double ovens, and oven-microwave combinations products were manufactured with a wire from an independent supplier that does not meet specifications. The insulation on the wire can melt, causing a short circuit and if not properly grounded, the product can present a shock hazard. Whirlpool has received no reports of incidents or injuries.

The model and serial number are located on a label inside the door of the units. **Representative Models:**
